

## LIGHTJET PRINTING FROM VECTOR FILES

### VECTOR TIPS:

- Use full postscript fonts and include them with your file. Multi-master fonts are not acceptable and true types are not recommended.
- Convert fonts to curves.
- Specify colors as "Pantone Coated" and use them at 100% opacity
- Include all the pieces that make up your final layout: all fonts, graphics, and scans that are linked to the file.
- Include a hardcopy: this is for layout purposes only and does not have to be color.

### COMPOSITE FILES(VECTOR FILES WITH RASTER ELEMENTS)TIPS:

- We recommend this software combination: Photoshop for images, Illustrator for logos, text and illustration, Quark to put the two together and layout the document.
- Remember that rasters are not scaleable. You might have to go back and rebuild if you do not have enough resolution for the final print size. View your document at 100% to check the resolution of your raster files.
- A tip for large documents. Create "position only" 72 dpi files from the raster files you intend to use in your document. This makes it easier to move and position large raster elements in your layout program. Be sure to include final print size rasters when submitting your files. Check that the final print size rasters are the correct resolution.
